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前 言

随着国家职业教育体系的逐步完善，通过中高职衔接进入高职院校学习已成为中职毕业生的主要选择。为帮助广大中等职业学校参加升学考试的学生全面、系统、高效地复习备考，我们组织了一批具有丰富中等职业教育教学经验的一线骨干教师，依据《中等职业学校英语课程标准（2020 年版）》（以下简称课标）和《中等职业学校公共基础课程方案》，结合四川省中等职业教育英语教学实际，在深刻理解课标，分析近 5 年真题及课标实施后职教高考改革趋势的基础上编写了本套试卷。

本套试卷面向广大参加普通高校对口招生统一考试（以下称统招考试）的中职职业学校学生，包含有 17 套模拟试卷，并附有最近 3 套统招真题。17 套模拟试卷针对统招考试设置题型，按照《中等职业学校英语课程标准》中学业质量水平二的要求进行编写，以满足统招考试复习冲刺阶段的学习需求；所附真题为 2020—2022 年统招考试真题。通过熟悉真题题型，提高学生语言综合运用能力和应试技巧，使其能够充分应对统招考试。

本套试卷定位准确、特色鲜明，针对性强，且具有一定的前瞻性，能够满足课程标准实施后学生参加中职统招考试的复习备考要求。可作为考前冲刺阶段的练习、测试使用，以检测本阶段的学习效果，准确把握考生水平，提高复习效果。学生既可在教师引导下进行复习和练习，也可通过本套试卷进行自主训练和检测。

由于编写时间仓促，且编者水平有限，不足之处在所难免，敬请广大师生提出宝贵意见，以便我们进一步修订、完善。

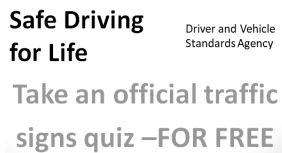

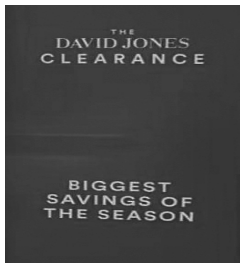

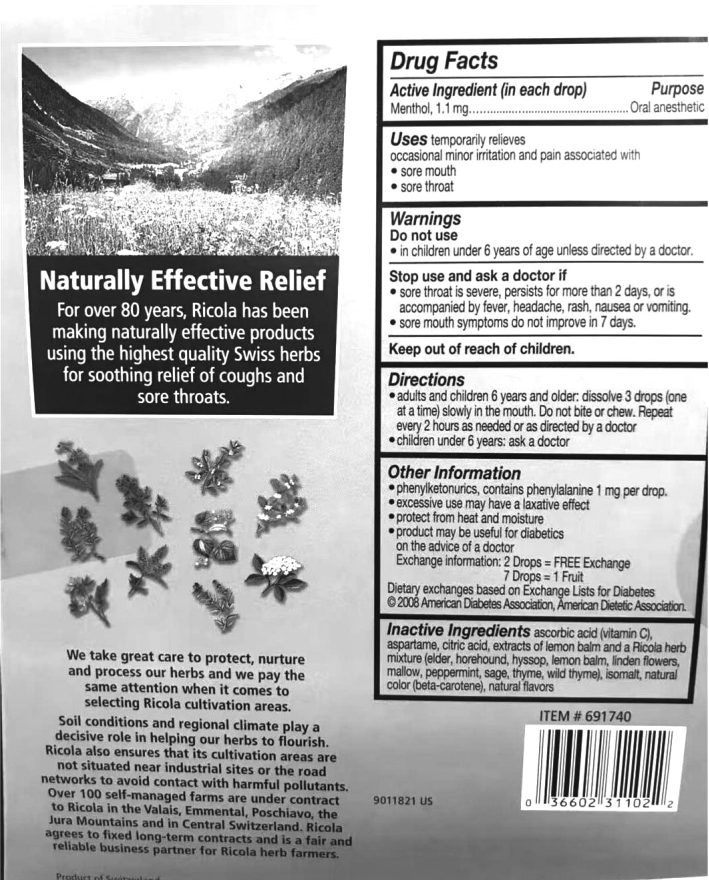
